

# Return to In-Person Worship

## What to Expect

- The blue doors on Vermont Ave. will open at 10am
  - The N St. door will be opened only for those who need to use the ramp
- The service will begin at 10:30am and end by 11:30am
- Everyone is to be masked and remain physically distanced
  - Pews will be sectioned off for people who would like to sit near each other who are already in “pods” together
- Follow the ushers’ directions and ask them questions you may have
- Discounted parking is not available at this time
  - The semi-circle is reserved for accessible parking
- Paper and digital bulletins will be available
- Childcare will not be provided, but the nursery will be open

## Music

- Instrumental music and solo/small group singing will be provided
- At this time, indoor congregational singing is prohibited, based on current recommendations from the CDC and other public health institutions
- Dancing, clapping, and other forms of body percussion are encouraged

## Holy Communion

- Monetary offerings will be accepted online, via text, and in an offering box near the altar
- The ushers will direct you to receive individual packets of the elements from the altar and signs will be placed for juice, wine, and gluten-free bread
- The ushers will dismiss congregants row by row
- We encourage socializing outdoors, where it is much safer to do so
